<p><b>A.</b> Inclement weather - Ground is slippery.</p>	<p>Performers</p>	<p>Low</p>	<p>Stilts are not to be used in wet weather. Care will be taken by performers ( good footwear to be worn ). Decisions to delay / change / cancel performances will be taken, with the organiser, where appropriate.</p>
<p><b>B.</b> Mobile Potting Shed Table bumping into a member of the public. Or them walking into it.</p>	<p>Public</p>	<p>Low</p>	<p>The trolley is a manual push cart, with only two wheels which when stationary is stable, resting on two legs The performers are highly experienced at manoeuvring the trolley in crowded areas. It is a highly visual prop, with a music system aboard, in the care of two experienced performers. This makes it unlikely for members of the general public to collide with it.</p>
<p><b>C.</b> Stilt walker falling over or onto a member of the public.</p>	<p>Public and Performers</p>	<p>Low</p>	<p>Performers are professionally trained in the use of stilts and safety pads are worn. The performers are highly experienced at stilt walking in crowded areas.</p>
<p><b>D.</b> Stilt walker pulled / pushed over by rowdy member of the public.</p>	<p>Public and Performers</p>	<p>Low</p>	<p>Performers are professionally trained in the use of stilts. If it is deemed necessary a steward will be requested for safety. Decisions to delay / change / cancel performances will be taken, with the organiser, where appropriate.</p>
